### DEVELOP YOUR FORESIGHT PRACTICE

The Foresight Practitioner Training is a nuts-and-bolts immersion in futures methodologies and tools. It is designed to help individuals and organizations grow their skills in the art and science of foresight—and to join a vibrant network of practitioners who can advance futures thinking in all kinds of organizations and communities around the globe.

The Foresight Practitioner Training is open to individuals, leaders, and teams who are ready and eager to establish or expand foresight in their organizations.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

**The three-day Foresight Practitioner Training is a hands-on, workshop-style event with intimate cohorts. It takes place at IFTF's Gallery of the Future in Palo Alto, California.** Led by top IFTF researchers, the training is designed to certify you as a futures thinker and facilitator.

**Before arriving** for the training program, you'll complete a series of get-ready exercises on the theory and practice of fundamental futures thinking processes and IFTF's Foresight-Insight-Action framework. Then, while on site at the *Gallery of the Future*, experiential activities will bring the foresight process to life as you apply your skills to specific organizational challenges.

**Upon completion** of the workshop, IFTF will award with you a certificate of completion as a foresight practitioner. As a foresight practitioner, you will have access to our original proprietary futures thinking tools and techniques, as well as new relationships with fellow practitioners-in-training and, as our alumni network continues to grow, an extended practitioners' network.

## WORKSHOP EXPERIENCE FOR CORE SESSIONS

### DAY 1

- › **BUILD** your foresight mindset and shared language for futures thinking
- › **LEVERAGE** hindsight to discover patterns of innovation and disruptions
- › **DISCOVER** powerful tools for identifying and analyzing signals of change
- › **DETERMINE** how to filter through all the information to get at what's important

### DAY 2

- › **EXPAND** horizons with four alternative futures
- › **EMBODY** human impact through future personas
- › **MAKE** the future tangible with artifacts from the future

### DAY 3

- › **PLOT** strategies on the first and second curves of the future
- › **DESIGN** experiments in future making
- › **EXPLORE** organizational structures that support a culture of foresight
